The club provides players with morning or afternoon tea under a limited budget. This food is not intended as a substitute for breakfast or lunch for members running late for a session!

Committee Decisions

Fee Increase:

The Committee has been advised that both the Australian Bridge Federation fees and the NSW Bridge Association Affiliation fees are to be increased next year. These fees are charged for each club member and together with printing costs for the Calendar, currently take all but \$1 of each club membership fee. Consequently the Committee has decided that the club membership fee for 2020 will be increased to \$35 per member.

'Novice' and 'Restricted' **Definitions**

The Committee agreed that Orange Bridge Club should have an overarching definition of 'Novice' and 'Restricted' for all our events unless otherwise specified by specific rules for particular competitions – e.g. Clark Trophy. It was agreed that 'Novice' players have less than 100 Master Points and 'Restricted' players have less than 300 Master Points.

New club events in 2020

The Committee has endorsed the recommendation of the Tournament Sub-Committee to hold some new events in 2020. There will be a "Teams of three" event held on Sunday 5th July and a "Speed Bridge" event on Saturday 18th July. More details about what these events involve will be provided closer to those dates.

Club Pairs Championship – Including a Novice section:

Note: this event is not just for the top players as there is a Novice Section for pairs where each pair member has less than 100 Master Points.
