PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Online Bridge

Many thanks to those who engaged last week with our online Stepbridge trial with 8 tables on both Monday afternoon and Friday morning.

After the successful pilot program, we will begin playing for masterpoints from this Monday onward with following sessions on Wednesday and Friday mornings. The Wednesday evening session did not attract sufficient interest and will be discontinued.

Cost of playing will be 50 participation points or \$3.30 per session which compares to the \$5.0 we pay at the Club. Of this Stepbridge keeps 20c per player and our club gets \$3.10 per player. This gives us some cash flow whilst we remain in lockdown.

Club Reopening

This is entirely dependent on government regulation. If we were to get out of lockdown which is possible next week if no COVID cases are recorded this week we will revert to the rules which applied at the time of lockdown.

- Facemasks to be worn at all times
- The QR code sign in to be observed
- All other aspects of the COVID Safe Plan to remain in place

Once we reach the 70 or 80% point where all venues can re-open the government has been quite

specific in that this will only be for people who have received two doses of an approved COVID vaccine.

Email Problems

Anne has been working with Pianola to resolve problems where some people are not receiving emails from the club. There appear to be two main issues

- 1. Members must tick the box which says they wish to receive emails from the Club
- 2. We need to establish a Domain name for the club. If emails come from a private email which is what the club currently has many computer settings will reject them and send them to quarantine or the junk file. Jenny King's son has kindly agreed to do this.

Hopefully these issues will shortly be resolved.

lessons for Club members. This has been deferred until 2022 with the current uncertainty regarding lockdowns


Personal
